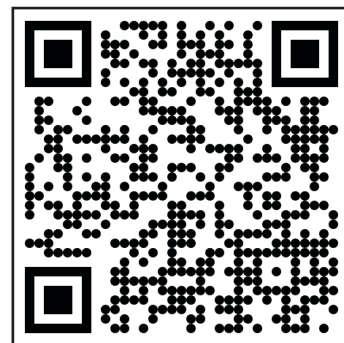
Who are our members?
